Registration Form on Back

Every adult **MUST** be an approved visitor; all minors **MUST** have their original birth certificate; all guardians **MUST** have stamped, court approved guardianship papers; if an adult accompanying the minor is not the parent or guardian, they must have a notarized letter from the parent giving them permission to bring their child to the prison. What is The Chowchilla Family Express?

Free Transportation

We provide free transportation for people to visit their loved ones in the Chowchilla women's prisons. All you have to do is register by filling out and mailing in the form on the back of this brochure. Please be sure to cut off the registration form when you mail it in so you can keep a copy of the bus schedule for yourself. We will send you a letter confirming your registration and notifying you of the time and place of the bus departure.

The Bus Trip

CFE does not provide food or water on the trip. You are welcome to bring beverages, food and snacks for the trip. Buses from Southern California will stop for dinner on the way home, so please bring money if you wish to purchase food. No alcohol or drugs are allowed.

The bus will leave promptly from our departure locations, so please don't be late! Two Hospitality Bus Leaders will ride each bus to help in any way they can to make sure we all have a safe trip and good visits.

Money

You are welcome to bring money for the vending machines inside the prison. The maximum you can bring is \$50 per adult and \$30 per child. We highly recommend bringing one-dollar bills and quarters to avoid change machine lines.

Prison Visiting Guidelines

We are all subject to prison visiting guidelines. Do not wear any blue pants or shirts, and no blue or green denim jeans.

Important

Registering for The Chowchilla Family Express is **NOT THE SAME** as becoming an approved visitor. You need to complete that paperwork. To be an approved visitor you have to fill out a 106 Form. The woman inside will mail you a "Visitor Questionnaire" for you to fill out and mail back to the Visiting Office at the prison, **NOT** to the woman in prison. The woman you are going to visit can tell you if you are approved. Approval lasts only two years, so please be sure that you are approved before you make the trip to Chowchilla. If you are not approved, there is nothing we can do to get you inside the prison to visit.

We accept registrations from families and loved ones, and not from the prisons: the families are making the trip so they are the ones who have to register. The dress code for the prison must be followed: no blue jeans or green jeans, and no blue, brown or green shirts or pants. No body piercings of any kind: tongue, eyebrow, nose, belly button, etc. Please don't wear ANY jewelry. It slows down the entire process of getting in to our visits.



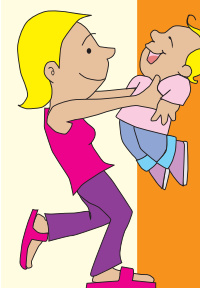
When filling out the registration form, please clearly fill out all lines. We need to be able to send you a confirmation letter with information about the departure location, so please clearly write your address.

If a trip is cancelled at the last minute for any reason, we need to be able to call you, so please include all your phone numbers. Call us if your phone number or address has changed.

Seating is limited so register **NOW** and call us if you need to cancel so we can give someone else your seat. The deadline to register is 7 days prior to the trip.

Things to bring:

(Most items have to stay on the bus and are not allowed inside the prison).

Pillow, blanket, food and books.

Bring anything you need for your children like toys, coloring books, diapers, baby food and so on.

If you need to bring medication, bring ONLY that days dosage; plus bring the prescription or doctor's note. If you get headaches or motion sickness when traveling, please bring Tylenol or other medications. We cannot dispense meds.

Bring all your documents: Adults need a valid California ID or passport, minors need relevant paperwork such as original birth certificates, stamped legal guardianship papers, notarized letters.
